Recycled asphalt (millings) can be reused as gravel material. Navajo Route 9062 was approved using millings.



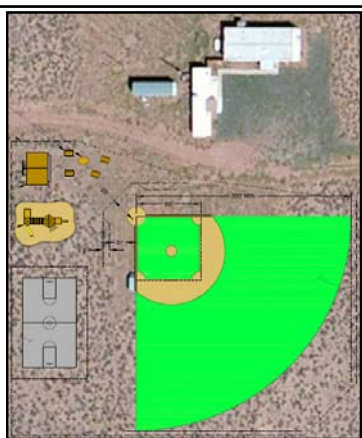
Did You Know?
