ADOT Millings

- Millings are recycled asphalt pavement created by leveling existing pavement before new pavement is placed.
- The source of the millings come from ADOT paving projects on Interstate 40. A limited resource
- Millings are stock piled the in locations along I 40.
- Navajo County authorized by the State surplus system to request millings from ADOT NE District.
- Navajo County provides millings to the Tribes for inventoried roads

Benefits of Millings

- Milling material is free
- The cost is the loading and hauling to the site
- A cost effective material if hauling is within 60 miles of stock pile
- Existing oils help bind millings together
- Less dust than gravel
- Construction water required for compaction
